

Sport Risk Assessment

All information contained in this risk assessment (and linked documents) is subject to change based on the advice from government and the changing local situation at each college site.

Sporting activities are allowed where they are part of the curriculum or as part of official team sports activities. Under the current guidance sports fixtures are allowed with restrictions on mixing between age groups when playing teams from other colleges.
