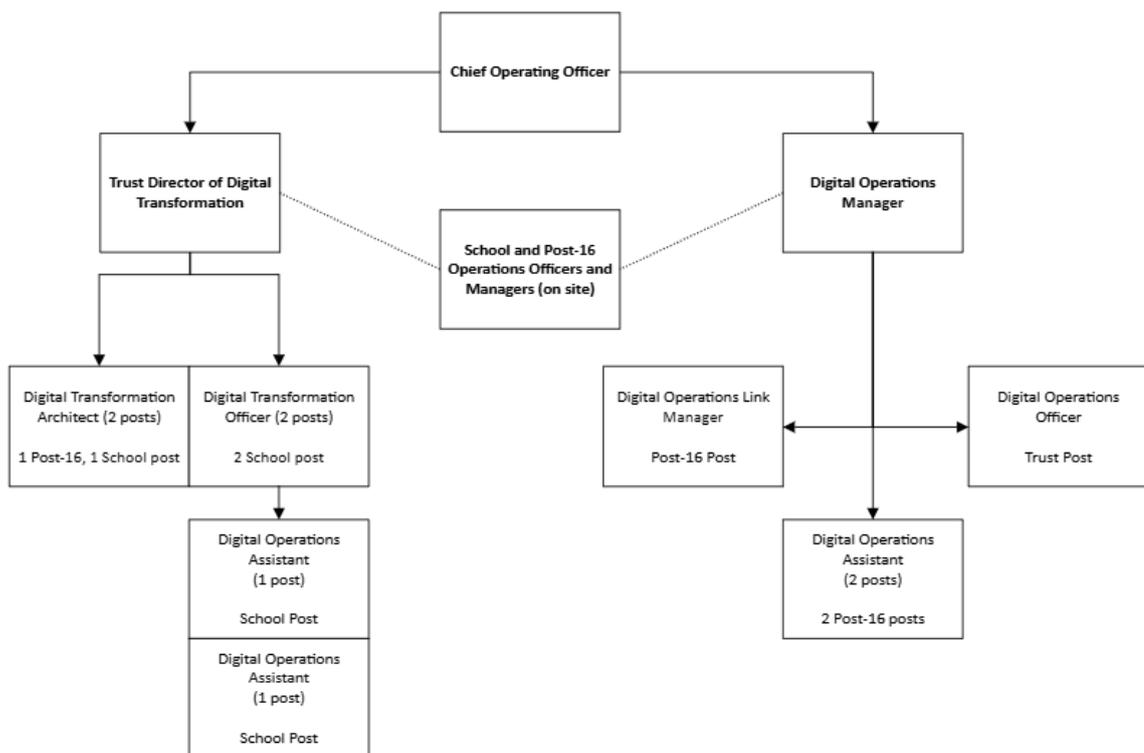


The Digital Team

The Digital Team oversees and supports all data-based systems across the Trust. The key function of the team is ensuring that the MIS are administered and configured to ensure that staff have work efficiently and effectively and get the analysis they need. The Digital Operations Manager has a key role in ensuring that all the connected processes and MIS systems support this function.

The Chief Operating Officer (Andy Woodcock) has been in post from September 2023 after previously overseeing the MIS and Students Services team from April 2022. He worked as a teacher and senior leader in Secondary Schools (with Post 16) and is driven by a passion to provide great systems for leaders across the Trust. The Trust Director of Digital Transformation (Steve Crisp) was appointed in June 2023 and has a high technical skill set which support systems across the Trust. The current functions and team members of the MIS, Data teams and Student Services were combined into the Digital team through a consultation process with the staff in April 2025. The Digital team contains staff who are experienced in administering MIS systems and innovating on different areas of data applications (Power BI, Claude, Data Warehousing, Power App Development).
